



Making it possible for all students of Ireland to take part in exchange programmes and internships in other European countries as well as progressing their education around the globe.


UNIVERSITY vs INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

The qualities of education in the Irish universities and institutes of technology revolves around the academic excellence and availability of scholarship. LIVING COST IN IRELAND



Living cost varies depending on lifestyle, location and accommodation. In general, student should be able to live on a budget of €10,000 – €15,000 for each academic year (9 months), excluding tuition fees. Cost of living will be slightly higher for students living in Dublin.

WORKING IN IRELAND

International student with a valid Immigration Permission of Stamp 2 (a full-time student) can work up to 40 hours per week during holidays and semester breaks. During academic periods, students are allowed to work up to 20 hours per week. According to the Irish Graduate Visa Scheme, international graduates with Master or PhD qualifications may remain in Ireland for up to 24 months upon the completion of their studies to look for full-time employment. An Honours Degree (Level 8) graduate may remain in Ireland as well for up to 12 months.
